





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City

as of 06 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2024 at around 7:49 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City, and was declared fire out at around 9:01 AM. Initial reports indicated that 45 residential houses were damaged resulting in the displacement of families and individuals.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, provided immediate relief assistance to meet the needs of the affected families and individuals. Additional support is anticipated following the completion of validation and upon request of the concerned Local Government Unit (LGU).

A total of 45 families or 225 persons are affected in Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City (see Annex A).
