





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alos, Alaminos City, Pangasinan

as of 07 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 February 2024 at around 6:25 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Alos, Alaminos City, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Alos, Alaminos City, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Alos, Alaminos City, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}13,178.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}10,017.50\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}3,161.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
