

## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balatubat, Calayan, Cagayan**

as of 27 February 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 19 February 2024 at around 3AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Balatubat, Calayan, Cagayan. Based on the report from the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) of the LGU of Calayan, Cagayan, the fire was caused by a bonfire that was left unextinguished.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **seven (7) families** or **22 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Balatubat, Calayan, Cagayan** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **two (2) families** or **four (4) persons** currently staying in temporary shelters built by the LGU in **Brgy. Balatubat, Calayan, Cagayan** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **five (5) families** or **18 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **seven (7) families** or **22 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Balatubat, Calayan, Cagayan** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **seven (7) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Balatubat, Calayan, Cagayan** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱23,898.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
