



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 8 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 11:13 AM, a fire incident occurred at Bantiles, Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 12:16 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of seven (7) families or 20 persons are affected in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of seven (7) families or 20 persons sought temporary shelter in Brgy. Covered Court in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱78,676.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱55,415.50 from DSWD and ₱23,261.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
