



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Canmogsay, Tolosa, Leyte

as of 28 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 March 2024 at around 1:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Canmogsay, Tolosa, Leyte. The Bureau of Fire (BFP) responded to the incident leading to the fire out on the same day.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VIII, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons were affected in Brgy. Canmogsay, Tolosa, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons temporarily stayed with relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Canmogsay, Tolosa, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,734.31** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
