





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu

as of 20 March 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024 at around 11:14 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:30 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 121 families or 481 persons are affected in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 121 families or 481 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 63 houses were damaged; of which, 60 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P36,500.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
