

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu as of 28 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 March 2024 at around 11:28 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:10 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱13,400.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which **₱3,400.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱10,000.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex D).
