### I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Purok Gumamela, Brgy. Caras-an, Tago, Surigao del Sur.

A total of six (6) families or 26 persons are affected in Brgy. Caras-an, Tago, Surigao del Sur (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are six (6) families or 26 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Caras-an, Tago, Surigao del Sur (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P44,914.94** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
