I. Situation Overview

On 06 February 2024 at around 1:09 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 5, Banava St., Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental.

One (1) family or two (2) persons are affected in Brgy. Carmen in Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Carmen in Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}11,239.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}7,916.50\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}3,323.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
