as of 28 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 3:41 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1A, Luzon Avenue, Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 5:52 PM.

A total of **185 families** or **493 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Culiat**, **Quezon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 185 families or 493 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Purok 4 Satellite Office in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 108 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City (see Annex C).
