

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City as of 28 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 3:41 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1A, Luzon Avenue, Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 5:52 PM.

A total of **185 families** or **493 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **185 families** or **493 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok 4 Satellite Office** in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **108 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex C).
