#### I. Situation Overview

On 29 February 2024 at around 8:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok San Juan, Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato.

A total of **78 families** or **231 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **78 families** or **231 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok San Juan Covered Court** in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex B).

A total of 45 houses were damaged; of which, 42 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato (see Annex C).
