

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato as of 01 March 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 29 February 2024 at around 8:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok San Juan, Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **78 families** or **231 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **78 families** or **231 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok San Juan Covered Court** in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **45 houses** were damaged; of which, **42** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex C).
