

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Daldalaquiten Norte, Sinait, Ilocos Norte

as of 08 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 8:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Daldalaquiten Norte, Sinait, Ilocos Norte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Daldalaquiten Norte, Sinait, Ilocos Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There is **one (1) family** or **seven (7) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Daldalaquiten Norte, Sinait, Ilocos Norte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱32,601.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱22,601.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
