I. Situation Overview

On 18 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sta. Cruz, Brgy. Dansolihon, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dansolihon, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Dansolihon, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱11,239.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱7,916.50** from **DSWD** and **₱3,323.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
