





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Doongan, Butuan City, Agusan del Norte

as of 28 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 March 2024 at around 02:28 PM, a fire incident in Purok 12 Brgy. Doongan, Butuan City. The fire was declared out at around 04:00 PM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region Caraga, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Butuan City, provided relief augmentation and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of seven (7) families or 28 persons are affected in Brgy. Doongan, Butuan City, Agusan del Norte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are four (4) families or 14 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Brgy. Doongan Multi-Purpose Hall in Butuan City, Agusan del Norte (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are seven (7) families or 28 persons displaced in Brgy. Doongan, Butuan City, Agusan del Norte (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and one (1) are partially damaged in Brgy. Doongan, Butuan City, Agusan del Norte (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}85,896.65\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}77,496.65\$ from the \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}8,400.00\$ from the \$\mathbb{Local Government}\$ Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
