





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. East Kibawe, Kibawe, Bukidnon

as of 15 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 February 2024 at around 11:18 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1A, Brgy. East Kibawe, Kibawe, Bukidnon. The fire was allegedly caused by an unplugged rice cooker that was left unattended. It was declared fire out at around 1:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **31 families** or **47 persons** are affected in **Brgy. East Kibawe, Kibawe, Bukidnon** (see Annex A). Most of the affected individuals are renters.

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 31 families or 47 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. East Kibawe Covered Court in Brgy. East Kibawe, Kibawe, Bukidnon (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. East Kibawe, Kibawe, Bukidnon (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}121,212.74\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}44,212.74\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}77,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex H).
