

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Eastern Poblacion, Poro, Cebu

as of 01 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 February 2024 at around 1:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Eastern Poblacion, Poro, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 3:10 AM.

A total of **13 families** or **14 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Eastern Poblacion, Poro, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Eastern Poblacion, Poro, Cebu** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱325,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱130,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱195,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
