

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Elias Aldana, Las Piñas City

as of 06 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2024 at around 1:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at Kurba St., Brgy. Elias Aldana, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 3:04 PM.

A total of **170 families** or **648 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Elias Aldana, Las Piñas City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **170 families** or **648 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Elias Aldana Covered Court** in **Brgy. Elias Aldana, Las Piñas City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **150 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Elias Aldana, Las Piñas City** (see Annex C).
