

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Guadalupe, Cebu City as of 28 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2024 at around 5:53 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Guadalupe, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 6:28 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **16 families** or **52 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Guadalupe, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **16 families** or **52 persons** took temporarily shelter at the **Guadalupe Multi Purpose Hall** in **Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **eight (8) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Guadalupe, Cebu City** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱463,875.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱117,620.00** from **DSWD** and **₱346,255.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
