as of 15 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 March 2024 at around 7:06 PM, a fire incident occurred Brgy. Himbangan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 7:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or 11 persons are affected in Brgy. Himbangan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Himbangan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P20,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
