

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Jose P. Rizal, Butuan City as of 27 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 March 2024 at around 10PM, a fire incident occurred at 7th St., Guingona Subdivision, Brgy. Jose P. Rizal, Butuan City. The fire was declared out at around 11:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **12 families** or **17 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Jose P. Rizal, Butuan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **17 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Jose P. Rizal, Butuan City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱147,251.40** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱132,851.40** from **DSWD** and **₱14,400.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
