

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lagasit, San Quintin, Pangasinan as of 07 March 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 20 February 2024 at around 1:19 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Lagasit, San Quintin, Pangasinan.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I together with the LGU of San Quintin, Pangasinan, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **19 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lagasit, San Quintin, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **six (6) families** or **19 persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Lagasit, San Quintin, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱168,202.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱68,202.00** from the **DSWD**, **₱75,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱25,000.00** from **Other Partners** (see Annex D).
