



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo

as of 26 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 March 2024 at around 12:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo. The fire was declared out at around 1:20 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **27 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **19 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center
 One (1) family or two (2) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population There are five (5) families or 21 persons displaced in Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱34,590.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
