

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu as of 13 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 12:06 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) immediately responded to the area. The fire was declared out at around 2:16 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **509 families** or **1,729 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **509 families** or **1,729 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **388 houses** were damaged; of which, **381** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).
