I. Situation Overview

On 10 March 2024 at around 11:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Our Lady of Lourdes, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 11:27 PM.

A total of **four (4) families** or **14 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Our Lady of Lourdes, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Our Lady of Lourdes, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱33,664.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
