I. Situation Overview

On 10 March 2024 at around 11:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Our Lady of Lourdes, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 11:27 PM.

A total of four (4) families or 14 persons are affected in Brgy. Our Lady of Lourdes, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Our Lady of Lourdes, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱33,664.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
