I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Parulan, Plaridel, Bulacan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of eight (8) families or 22 persons are affected in Brgy. Parulan, Plaridel, Bulacan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **22 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Parulan, Plaridel, Bulacan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}16,000.00\$ worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex D).
