I. Situation Overview

On 22 March 2024 at around 11:04 PM, a fire incident occurred at NIA Road, Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 11:53 PM.

A total of **55 families** or **180 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **55 families** or **180 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Pinyahan Gymnasium Hall** in **Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

A total of **15 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City** (see Annex C).

25 March 2024	 The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Quezon City provided hot meals to the affected families and individuals, and facilitated the setting up of a community kitchen.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

DATE	ACTIVITIES
25 March 2024	 The LGU of Quezon City through its Social Services and Development Department (SSDD) continuously conducts intake interviews, assessment, validation and master listing of the affected families and individuals using the Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC). The LGU of Quezon City through its SSDD also facilitated the setting up of a child-friendly space area at the evacuation center.

d. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
25 March 2024	 DSWD FO NCR continuously coordinated with the LGU of Quezon City and other concerned offices for significant updates and any relief augmentation requests. DSWD FO NCR ensured the availability of FNIs for possible augmentation support.
