## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pio del Pilar, Makati City**

as of 22 March 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 19 March 2024 2023 at around 6:38 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pio del Pilar, Makati City and was declared fire out at around 7:30 PM. The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community with five (5) houses completely destroyed.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **five (5) families** or **27 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pio del Pilar, Makati City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **four (4) families** or **23 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Parada Covered Court** in **Brgy. Pio del Pilar, Makati City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **five (5) families** or **27 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Pio del Pilar, Makati City** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **five (5) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pio del Pilar, Makati City** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱23,428.25** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
