I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2024 at around 11:51 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out the next day at around 1:11 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

A total of **57 families** or **237 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

There are **57 families** or **237 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at a **community center** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

A total of **20** houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong (see Annex C).
