





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz

as of 28 February 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Rizal Street in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 103 families or 366 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 71 families or 268 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Rufina Andrada Santos Memorial School in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex B).

# b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **98 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are 103 families or 366 persons displaced in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex F).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 100 houses were damaged; of which, 98 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex G).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,401,424.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱876,424.00 from DSWD and ₱525,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex H).


