## I. Situation Overview

On 22 February 2024 at around 1:03 AM, a fire incident occurred at Tondo St., Brgy. Polo, Alaminos City, Pangasinan.

There is **one (1) family** or **one (1) person** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was totally damaged in Brgy. Polo, Alaminos City, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱13,178.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱10,017.50 from DSWD and ₱3,161.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
