





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pungtod, Oslob, Cebu

as of 27 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 March 2024 at around 4:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pungtod, Oslob, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 5:20 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 18 persons are affected in Brgy. Pungtod, Oslob, Cebu (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **18 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, four (4) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Pungtod, Oslob, Cebu (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P34,522.80** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
