

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sampaguita, Dagami, Leyte as of 21 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024 at around 8:53 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sampaguita, Dagami, Leyte.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field VIII, actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for any significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

There are **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Sampaguita Brgy. Hall** in **Dagami, Leyte** (see Annex B).

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sampaguita, Dagami, Leyte** (see Annex C).
