I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 7:02 PM, a fire incident occurred at Lovewin Street in Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 1:25 AM.

A total of **300 families** or **900 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **300 families** or **900 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **160 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City** (see Annex C).
