I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 7:02 PM, a fire incident occurred at Lovewin Street in Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 1:25 AM.

A total of 300 families or 900 persons are affected in Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 300 families or 900 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 160 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Isidro, Parañaque City (see Annex C).
