





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte

as of 14 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 3:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, Saint Arnold, Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 5:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 39 families or 175 persons are affected in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 39 families or 175 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Surigao City National High School in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 38 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P442,684.61** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱26.36 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) available at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO Caraga.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 99,014 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 86,945 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 12,069 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 62,196 FFPs available at DSWD FO Caraga.
- ₱463.29 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO Caraga warehouses.
