I. Situation Overview

On 08 March 2024 at around 5:09 AM, a fire incident occurred between 18th and 19th Avenues, Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 6:38 AM.

There are 180 families or 648 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City (see Annex B).
