

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City as of 11 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 March 2024 at around 5:09 AM, a fire incident occurred between 18th and 19th Avenues, Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 6:38 AM.

A total of **180 families** or **648 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **180 families** or **648 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **76 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Roque, Quezon City** (see Annex C).
