
DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sangali, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur as of 07 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2024 at around 4:56 PM, a fire broke out at Brgy. Sangali, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 7:30 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region IX promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the displaced families and individual. Simultaneously, maintains close coordination with the City Social Welfare and Development Office of Zamboanga City, for further relief augmentation requests.

A total of **32 families** or **137 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sangali, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **137 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Sangali Covered Court in Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **27 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Sangali, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱129,424.00** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
