## I. Situation Overview

On 23 March 2024 at around 3:20 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. South Poblacion, Larena, Siquijor. The fire was declared out at around 5:00 PM.

# b. Outside Evacuation Center One (1) family or three (3) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

# c. Total Displaced Population There are two (2) families or ten (10) persons displaced in Brgy. South Poblacion, Larena, Siquijor (see Annex D).

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. South Poblacion, Larena, Siquijor (see Annex E).
