

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. South Signal, Taguig City as of 13 March 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 March 2024 at around 9:10 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 6, Brgy. South Signal, Taguig City. The fire was declared out at around 9:43 AM.

A total of **nine (9) families** or **33 persons** are affected in **Brgy. South Signal, Taguig City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **33 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. South Signal, Taguig City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱49,200.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
