

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan as of 08 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **11 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱45,551.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱30,052.50** from **DSWD** and **₱15,499.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
