## I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan.

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or 11 persons are affected in Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) was partially damaged in Brgy. Tangcarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱45,551.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱30,052.50 from DSWD and ₱15,499.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 108,314 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 100,345 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 7,969 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 31,560 FFPs available at DSWD FO I.
- ₱526.28 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO I warehouses.
