

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tinago, Cebu City as of 27 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 1:43 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio St. Lucia, Brgy. Tinago, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 5:09 AM.

A total of **31 families** or **116 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tinago, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **31 families** or **116 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in a **gymnasium** in **Brgy. Tinago, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **14** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tinago, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
