





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Viga, Antequera, Bohol

as of 15 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Viga, Antequera, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 11:10 AM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Viga, Antequera, Bohol (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Viga, Antequera, Bohol (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P500.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected family (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 91,414 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 86,945 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 4,469 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 76,271 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱472.59 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.

DSWD FO VII referred the affected family to the Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Bohol for further assessment and provision of financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS).
