

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incidents in Davao Occidental

as of 02 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 29 February 2024 at around 04:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Caraga and Davao Region.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Sta. Maria in Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to Easterlies that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,109 families** or **7,591 persons** are affected in **12 barangays** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **513 families** or **1,711 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were damaged; of which, **17** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex C).
