On 07 March 2024 at around 8:00 PM, a vehicular incident occurred along the national road in Brgy. San Juan, Ilagan City, Isabela that resulted in several casualties.

- 93,314 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 86,945 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 6,369 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

- ₱494.34 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.
