





DSWD DROMIC Report #15 on the Landslide Incidents in Maco, Davao de Oro

as of 30 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 06 February 2024 at around 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Davao Region, SOCCSKSARGEN, Southern Leyte, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, and Surigao del Sur.

On the same day at approximately 7:40 PM, a landslide caused by the effects of Easterlies occurred in Barangays Elizalde, Mainit, Masara, and Tagbaros in Maco, Davao de Oro. The incident resulted in the displacement of families and individuals, and several reported casualties.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,426 families** or **9,035 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Maco, Davao de Oro** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 138 families or 420 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Maco, Davao de Oro (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 1,098 houses were totally damaged in Maco, Davao de Oro (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}7,547,335.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}6,917,335.00\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}630,000.00\$ from the \$\mathbb{Local Government}\$ Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
